

GOOD: ITS SPIRITUAL REALITY AND EARTHLY PRESENCE

Part I

Why this cover story? The June 10, 1991 edition of Time magazine revealed a basically dark cover with the word EVIL in large, black letters across it. Under that huge word was this question: "Does it exist—or do bad things just happen?"

I bought the magazine, read the feature, but was not very much moved by the author. The cover was clearly impressive, but the writer really did not penetrate into metaphysical mysteries or come to any great conclusions. As I was thinking about this month's Leo 1991 cover for Welcome To Planet Earth, I thought about how little people focus on Goodness and the enormous spiritual power in the Good. Hence, the cover of this issue.

The Random House Dictionary of the English Language (College Edition) defines "evil" as "1. morally wrong; immoral; wicked 2. harmful: injurious 3. unfortunate; disastrous " while "good" is described as "1. morally excellent; virtuous; righteous 2. satisfactory in quality. quantity, or degree 3. right; proper; fit 4. well-behaved. Later on this dictionary brings up words like "Good Book" (meaning the Bible), "good egg," "good day," "Good Friday," "Goodman" (as in Benny Goodman) and even the "Good Neighbor Policy."

I mention all this because the word "GOOD" has almost become invisible and forgotten in our fast-paced, materialistic lives. It's there, in all those names, but very few people really wonder about its origins and spiritual source. It is EVIL that receives all the headlines, the glamorous stories, the fanfare and human beings' fears and worries. But what about GOOD?

Does it exist—or do great things just happen accidentally, at random, with no purpose, meaning or direction?

Many years ago I turned on the television and "accidentally" found a program in which an Indian guru was giving a talk to his disciples about the Good and Goodness. The more I listened, the more amazed I became. I realized that I had never in my whole life ever heard anyone talk so long and so beautifully about the power of Goodness and how the Good as a spiritual reality could turn one's life around for the "better." The more this person talked about the Good and evoked its presence, the more this meeting of minds and hearts became other-worldly and uplifting. It became contagious in his audience, a Good virus ready to do its work among a population diseased by Evil, Ignorance and conscious darkness.

In the mid-1970s I worked at the Lucis Trust/Arcane School (the Alice A. Bailey/ Tibetan Master D.K. center) in New York City. I bought and studied their astounding books on metaphysics for many years. There was one quote in the final book of the series—The Rays and The Initiations—that I have always remembered as a powerful statement about the reality of Goodness. Here it is (pages 58-59): "Have I succeeded in giving you a somewhat wider vision of the significance of initiation in these brief expositions? Do you see more clearly the growing beauty of the Whole and the goodness of the Purpose and the wisdom of the Plan? Do you realize more deeply that beauty, goodness and wisdom are not qualities, as their inadequate nomenclature would imply, but are great facts in manifestation? Do you grasp the truth that they are not descriptive of Deity but are the names of Lives of a potency and activity of which men can as yet know nothing?"

Re-read that last portion of the final question: "names of Lives of a potency and activity of which men can as yet known nothing." When I read that for the first time some 17 years ago, a chill went up and down my spine. Goodness. Beauty. Wisdom. Not mere qualities. Names of Lives. If it is true that to have "genius" means, literally, "to be inhabited by a genie," could it be that by being "good," radiating goodwill to friends, family members and the world, that one could become an emissary or warrior of the "Good," where Goodness is a real spiritual Presence and Cosmic Life?


Not long after reading The Rays and The Initiations, I came across Maurice Nicoll's phenomenal book on the parables of Christ, called The New Man. If you want to read one book that focuses like a laser beam on the issues of Goodness, Truth and the Spiritual Life, this is it. One of the foundations of Nicoll's work is that The New Testament was basically written for us today, modern humanity of the 20th century, as a kind of psychological handbook, allowing as to become men and women of Goodwill. And the "key" to understanding the parables and the plot was that "Jesus" and "Christ" were, in effect, two different beings or two different energies. As Nicoll states on page 55: "Jesus always represents, in miracles, the power of Good acting on Truth and making it living."





Re-read that sentence before moving on. Everywhere Jesus is mentioned in **The New Testament** symbolizes the power of Good; everywhere Christ is mentioned represents the power of Truth. The truly advanced human being must fuse personality and soul, the Christ and the Jesus of his or her whole spiritual existence. Nicoll's premise was that the mysterious power that made Jesus such a remarkable figure was his identification with the healing presence of the Good—not necessarily his command of the Truth or his knowledge of religious laws. This short Penguin paperback book is a must if you love the Bible and want to understand The New Testament and the power for Good in the world on a higher level.

Good: Does it exist—or do great things just happen? I believe there is a real spiritual life that we can call Good. When a human being becomes a force for Good in the world, that individual is impregnated by the life quality of that vast entity known as the Good. A beautiful looking person may be an emissary of the spiritual life or presence we can call Divine Beauty. It's a reality—not a fiction, illusion or glamour. So, too, will a wise human being become the literal "personification" of the dynamic presence of Wisdom which resides on some exalted level of existence we know nothing about.

For many years, an organization known as World Goodwill has suggested Noon (local time) on Wednesday everywhere in the world as a time for offering up prayers and healing thoughts regarding the empowerment of goodwill throughout humanity and Planet Earth. Noon Wednesday is the heart or center of the 168-hour week that begins at Mid-night Sunday and ends at 11:59:59PM on Saturday night. If you want to increase the positive voltage of goodwill energizing our globe, this is one way you can be of service to our struggling Spaceship Earth. Fire and water have a delicate balance in nature and within our bodies. Fire in the body is the energy molecule called ATP or adenosine triphosphate. You can think of ATPs as miniature stars. ATPs allow us to think, move, digest, repair, and regulate our body temperature. Water naturally cools us or warms us depending on its temperature. It detoxes the body and creates flow wherever it is needed.

Water naturally runs down from the tops of mountains

into streams, creeks, and rivers as it goes down to the sea. While the water tumbles over and between rocks, gravel and sand, it is purified and mineralized. The movement in a spiral torrent becomes hydrogenated, allowing the water to act as an antioxidant. Now the water has high energy and the ability to give life to the plants, animals, and humans that drink it. The hydrogen and oxygen molecules that form water help break down foods, create enzymes, and create the fire energy molecules ATP.

But what causes water to be detrimental? When the water enters the municipalities, they screen it for bacteria and turgidity created by dirt molecules. The chemical used to kill off the bacteria, such as E. coli and other microbes, is chlorine. Fluorine is another gas that is infused into the water in some states in the U.S. to help prevent tooth decay.

Unfortunately, these chemicals have a deleterious effect on the thyroid gland because the negatively charged moles of chlorine and fluorine can displace the iodine the thyroid needs to make its' hormone thyroxine. When thyroxine is not functioning accurately, the fire energy drops in all cells, and weight problems, depression, sleep issues, and skin and hair problems may develop.

You can ensure quality water for you and your loved ones by drinking water from steel or glass and avoiding plastic bottles that leach chemicals into your drinking water. At the very least, get a Brita filter for filtering your water.



Leaving water out overnight or boiling water allows the chlorine and fluorine to release as a gas, so you are not consuming it. Water filters for the house and refrigerators are another way to filter out chemicals.

Water helps to hydrate all cells and carries the minerals, vitamins, and protein molecules known as amino acids and essential fatty acids into the blood. The energy and electrical signaling throughout the nervous system smoothly flow by water. Wastes are taken out of the body by water, facilitating detoxification. Water must cleanse and maintain pressure for clear eyesight free of floaters, dryness, cataracts, and glaucoma. Water also helps float the crystalline hairs in the inner ear, which gives us hearing and balance.

The ringing of the ears or tinnitus can be due to a lack of hydration, causing these hairs to fall over or rub against each other. Constipation is another sign of dehydration because the body absorbs as much water from the stool as possible to get the water to run its systems.

It is great to have a glass of water when you feel hungry because our bodies often signal a craving for food that is actually for water. Drink a glass of water, wait 20-30 minutes, and if the hunger goes away, it is just a call for water. Now that the water has been drunk, the body has what it needs to help break down food molecules.

There are two inappropriate times to drink water. Drinking lots of water or fluids at mealtime dilutes the fire energy of digestion. Diluted stomach acids make it harder for the body to break down and absorb nutrients. Water dampening the fire energy of digestion makes it more likely to get acid indigestion. Acid indigestion occurs because the water or other liquids float the digestive acids on top, causing burping or acid reflux. The additional time to not drink a lot of water or fluids is the first hour or two after eating, depending on how fast you digest a meal, because this may also dilute the enzymes and cause gas and bloating.



The fire energy of digestion can be increased by warming or heating foods and herbs such as garlic, chili peppers, black pepper, onion, chives, ginger, cinnamon, peppermint, spearmint, and sage. These foods and herbs have fire energy that also warms the body and can dry up damp conditions such as runny noses, moist coughs, and congestion in the throat or lungs.

The fire energy that is regulated by the thyroid controls our metabolism and body temperature. We get thyroxine from the thyroid, which helps all our cells function more easily at making the ATP energy molecule. This ATP fire energy controls the signaling of our nerves to move our muscles according to our mind's orders and allows our souls to create on this plane of existence as we choose.

Our energetic brain is like a car engine; it needs the radiator's coolant to keep it from overheating. Water cools and floats our brain in its skull, allowing us to utilize its vast calculating and creative abilities. We can improve our brain's cognition by feeding it some energizing herbs such as; rosemary, bacopa, and lemon balm that all fire up awareness. Make tea with these herbs, and you will utilize the water element to further the fire element within your mind. The energy we refer to as light is the fire element that cognizes inspiration and insights and forms the energy bodies of our chakras, meridians, and aura energy systems.








This will help you determine whether this decision requires more of your logical mind or more of your emotional heart and soul.

Next, try writing down a list including your ultimate goal related to the issue / decision and write down your:

- Top 3 priorities in life now
- Top 3 priorities in life future
- Top 2 obstacles
- Fears
- · Feelings and emotions

After you create your list, evaluate it.

What does the list tell you? Does it help you move in one direction over another? Were you honest or did you catch yourself writing down what you think you should feel and not what you really feel? (A common trap)

It might take you a few tries to get your list painfully honest.

Our personal values inventory evolves as we move throughout different stages of our lives so it is important to check-in and see what has changed. Often our decisions align with what values are prioritized in that moment of our life.

If you are still struggling after your list, I recommend a daydream, if you will. Play out the situation two different ways. What does the effect of your decision one way or another look like? How does it sound? How do others react? How does it make you feel? Do you like it? Where do you end up?

Communication is not just an important skill set with others. You communicate with yourself 24/7, consciously and unconsciously. And how you communicate with yourself is critical.



All We Know Of Heaven

When I was small my father carried me down steep and rocky paths to lakes, rivers and the sea. Bodies of water became like second homes during my youth. Nothing Mother Nature could proffer quelled the quiet assurance I experienced in his loving arms. I don't remember ever hearing the words from him, but the gentle manner in which he'd scoop me up whenever the way ahead became remotely dangerous, was love expressed to me. Growing up in the 1950s and 60s in rural Oregon was paradise. No matter what Dad pursued - piloting our boat, dancing with Mom, repairing vehicles, water skiing or awaiting a pitch during casual neighborhood baseball games, he exuded strength and earned the respect of everyone around him. I believed there wasn't anything he couldn't accomplish.

Water was the key element in which my dynamic father dwelled. We boated, kayaked, swam and floated our way throughout the Northwest. We scampered in the ocean waves, climbed up dunes and slid back down them on our backsides. I enjoyed watching my father take part in our activities as much as the antics themselves. It made me so happy to see our sometimes stern father laugh and play like a child. Occasionally, Dad would take me by the hand and walk with me along the docks, pointing out how the boats were constructed and their operation. He served in the Navy during WWII as a tail gunner on the battleship, Manila Bay. He never spoke of it, but when I was about 7, I found his mariner's journal and read of his harrowing experiences during some of the terrible battles of the South Pacific and was so disturbed to think he narrowly even made it home from that war. I don't know if I came to love the water through him or if it was a natural inclination for me as well, but any activity on or near it was always a pleasure for me. We slept on the ground and feasted on the fish my father caught. I believed that the future was full of potential, but those blissful trips to the waterways of Oregon are seen now through a curtain of pain.



That quiet confidence I enjoyed while young has sometimes eluded me in my adult life. The way seems often fraught with perilous events and relationships. We were raised up to be self-reliant, never complain and to take what comes with a measure of grace. I've tried to follow those principles, but often fall short. In the dark of night, when the trials of the day come to taunt me, I visualize my father picking me up. It's remarkable, but I can still see and smell him. His scent was a pleasant potpourri of machinery, strong soap and the woods. I was always watching him, all the little details, gestures and mannerisms I recall now with piercing lucidity. A family member once said, "You came into this world loving your father."

For the most part, I keep this knowledge to myself. Few want to hear about the departed. An abyss of grief has confronted me for more than 40 years. It is an impenetrable void from which I can find no way across. I think it's possible to love someone too much. But how does a child know to maintain affections in moderation? It is only in the hard, cold plane of adulthood that such restraint is honed. Tennyson posed that "It is better to have loved and lost than never to have loved at all"...but I wonder.

One day in July 1967, the Pacific took my beloved father's vital life and with it, all the security I would ever know. Troubled thoughts come unbidden surrounding my father's untimely passing. I see him, struggling against the waves and I am lost. In those last moments, was he thinking of us, those whose lives which would be so dramatically altered by the ending of his? Did he think of me, his raven-haired daughter who shadowed him in life? These are questions with no answers. Our family drifted in the savage current of life for years; appalling experiences befell us all. There were no "grief counselors" or help from any quarter. The one bright spot I focused most of my energy on during that shadowy time was my little sister Lisa, not yet 3 when our vibrant father's life ended. Sometimes, I think she came into the world to help us all cope with the tragedy soon to come. She has remained a constant source of sunshine in our sometimes dark, familial world. Eventually, most of my remaining family grounded themselves in the earth with productive and fulfilling lives. I've always worked, managed to stay solvent, maintained enduring friendships and had my own small family, but I never truly came ashore.

I avoid weddings and large gatherings, especially those with pairs of loving parents or anything involving fathers dancing with or celebrating their daughters. I don't covet what they have in any way; it just reminds

me of what we lost. My father is like a ghost. There have been many nights when I have awoken from a deep sleep, hearing my father's voice simply saying my name, nothing more, just my name. I awaken, "Dad, Dad, are you here?" Only the echo of his nocturnal summons hangs in the air. His voice, like everything else about him, was very distinctive. He has been the most frequent subject in my dreamscape since his death. Some nighttime expeditions are great; I'm on a quest to find him. When I finally do, he sees me and folds me into his arms. I'm so excited to bring him home to my siblings, my mother – inexpressible joy.

When I wake, of course, I realize it was only a dream, and the day is usually a gray one, regardless of the weather. My objective in these dreams is always the same. I desperately want to re-connect with him, talk with him, see his beautiful face, but more than anything, tell him how much he was, and is, loved. In so many of the dreams, I discover him somewhere far from home, ranching in the southwestern desert, building bridges in some faraway city or working in a fishing community on the eastern seaboard. I rush up to him with such elation. He sees me as a stranger. I remind him who I am (since I'm older now than when he died) and how much I've missed him. My entreaties to make him understand, to recognize and claim me as his daughter fall on deaf ears. He doesn't care; he has a new family now, and doesn't have any recollection of being our patriarch and usually turns his back on me and walks away.

Dreams of the latter variety are so painful I feel myself elevating, flying like a bird to escape the cruelty of his rejection.

I'm far above him, his second family mere specks on the earth below. Some dreams are so powerful that they remain as memories with more clarity than waking life. One in particular - My once energetic father is alive but paralyzed and confined to

a wheelchair. We are at a family outing up the North Umpqua River and everyone else is engaged in campsite activities. Dad is trying to gain everyone's attention, making all kinds of insightful suggestions about building the fire, setting up tents and other necessities. No one is paying him any mind. I am sitting on the ground at his side, my hand on his knee. He is getting very upset, "Why are they ignoring me?" he asks, exasperated. I try to reassure him, to comfort him. He keeps attempting to obtain their notice to no avail. Tears well up in his eyes. "Don't let it get to you, Dad, they love you, they just can't hear you," I tell him. "But you can," he replies. I nod and pat his knee. "Why do you suppose that is?" I ask. His answer is a simple one, "Nancy, it's because you're with me." I awoke in the middle of the night, feeling as if I had something far more powerful than a dream, more like a visitation.

As Father's Day looms, Melancholy - often whispering in my ear - sometimes gains an audience. I walk quickly past the store displays for "gift ideas" or avoid the shops altogether. Televised commercials intent on getting people to spend Father's Day dollars on their products are quickly muted. I don't begrudge others their celebratory day; I just don't want to think about it any more than my troubled mind can bear. Sometimes I imagine having him over for dinner, a beautiful meal, and all courses lovingly homemade by my hands. It saddens me that I never cooked for my father. Careless people complain about having to deal with elderly or cantankerous parents. I can't help think how much I'd be willing to sacrifice for the privilege of taking care of my father in his declining years. When I hear such banter, I want to scream - to rage.


And yet, I do nothing but stuff a lifetime of desolation a little farther within. Family members too young, or not yet conceived while my father was alive don't understand. They think I dwell too much. They have no idea.

My maternal grandmother guided me into the world of poetry at an early age. She departed this life 2 years before my father. I discovered Emily Dickinson while most of my peers were beginning to discover boys. A line from one of my favorites, "Parting is all we know of heaven, and all we need of hell" resonated profoundly following Dad's demise. Circumstances were certainly all we needed of hell for many years. Often it feels like I'm only here as a half-person. The other portion of myself was buried in the ground with my father. I was only 14, but I felt a tangible departure from deep within as they lowered his casket in the ground. There is no way to convey such despondency, I believe only those who've experienced similar loss can comprehend it.

A man, who would go on to become my closest friend, imparted his first impression of our meeting almost 20 years ago. He said he recognized and was drawn to the sadness in my eyes. I was both moved and surprised. I thought I managed to cover it fairly well. He's a sensitive soul, but I had no idea that my quiet despair was evident to anyone.

The solitary benefit that emerged from all this is I have learned to find happiness in small doses. Little victories, pleasant exchanges, the beauty of nature and the affection shared with family and friends are precious to me. I love and have loved many others on this journey, but I keep myself in check. I turn the damaged side of my heart inward. I persevere, but self-possessed. I wouldn't have wanted any other family and certainly any other father, but sometimes I think perhaps it's not better to have loved and lost. Sometimes. My father carried me when I was small and I will carry him in my heart until I take my last breath.

MERCURY LOGOSIS AND THE VENUSIAN DILEMMA

Mercury Logosis

This technique requires a discernment between what we know (Mercury) and who we are (Sun), between the idea-generating intellect of Mercury and the Sun as the mystery of being. Natal Mercury is placed either one sign behind the Sun, in the same sign as the Sun, or one sign ahead of the Sun. When Mercury is one sign behind the Sun, it can suggest a weaker capacity to articulate oneself. Finding words to explain or describe our perspective may be challenging, or maybe slower than we'd like it to be. This may not indicate a lower I.Q., but rather an innate sense that one's ideas are somehow behind one's being. It can be like understanding something without knowing it as firsthand experience. With this Logosis, there can also be a nostalgia for the past or a thinking and speaking style that favors the past tense.

When Mercury is in the same sign as the Sun, there can be an identification with ideas, a process accentuated when Sun and Mercury are conjunct in the same sign. I think therefore I am. This can be a challenging position when others critique our ideas and sources of information, and "being in and of itself remains beyond criticism as it inhabits a singular point beyond dualistic thinking. The Mercury/Sun conjunction can symbolize the mental habit for confusing our ideas for who we are.

When Mercury is placed in the sign ahead of the Sun, the intellect tends towards more forward-thinking without the mental baggage of identifying with any ideas it entertains. Ideas are viewed as autonomous agencies



agencies that light and leave, from mind to mind, like honeybees over fields of clover. There can be instances of prescience and even prophecy with this placement, where future outcomes can be seen and predicted.

The Venusian Dilemma

The placement of natal Venus determines how the magnetic force of personal love can be experienced. The experience of love to one person can be something else altogether to another, depending on the style and state Venus is in. This difference of Venusian styles can account for misunderstandings and conflicts in relationships where either party insists that their notion and definition of love is more valid than the other's. Love can be so dogmatic at times. Natal Venus is always placed either one or two signs behind the Sun, in the same sign. Those with the Venusian Dilemma of Sun conjunct Venus may first have to realize a higher level of

self-acceptance and self-love before feeling ready to share their love with another. When Venus is in the same sign as the Sun, the affectionate nature can be embodied as charm, charisma, grace and animal magnetism. This becomes more evident with tighter Sun/Venus conjunctions. This conjunction can represent the experience of being the love that you seek.

When Venus is ahead of the Sun by one or two signs, affections may be quicker to rise into expression. The dilemma for such a person and for their beloved can occur if the former expects the latter to match their own quick to affection responses. Those with Venus ahead of the Sun may fall quicker in love and maybe faster than the beloved can reciprocate; frustrations and misunderstandings ensue.

Overall, the Venusian Dilemma testifies to how each person can know and experience love differently and with its own distinct sense of timing and expression. It can also show how love can deepen and mature as differences are accepted, embraced and celebrated between friends, lovers and others.








Can you imagine what pours through our mindstream (stream of consciousness) even in a single day? Mind stream? It's more like a mind river or at times even a storm surge. And what remains? Not much, some impressions and selected memories, all in a day.

Those memories, however, are not all nostalgia either. We equally are imprinted by or remember the good, the bad, and the ugly. And the tip-of-the-top, the 'best of the lot' of memories, whether loved or hated, are reserved for the museum of our Self. And then there are the fixations.

As I like to say, attachment is the glue that holds the self together, and if something really impacts us, for better or for worse, it becomes part of our Self and we begin to identify with it as "us." And that, my friends, is sticky. Again, don't fool yourself into thinking that our self is made up only of treasured or much-loved moments. It is not about nostalgia. Once we identify with something, good or bad (and it is up to us), it goes into the closet of the Self and remains there until its memory is worn out of existence or we can release it. And that can be a long time. Like a sore tooth, we keep peeking (by reaction) to see if it is still sensitive, and that is what keeps it forever

on our mind. We further underscore it every time it comes up and we react. This is the nature of the Self.

And the key to freedom from self-dependence, is the fact that the Self is composed of many distinct impressions and is not simply a unified whole entity like we imagine. Like the seeds in a sunflower, and there are many, each of our reactions is a separate seed or impression. Because the self is blind and has no overview of its own "self" (meaning that it is not an entity), it can be successfully deconstructed one memory at a time. This is the beauty of the dharma practice called Tonglen that I have been describing in "Tonglen: The Alchemy of Reaction"



As mentioned, the Self is not of one piece (there is no Over-Self), and the individual pieces that make up the Self are not of the same degree of imprint. Some are stronger or deeper, while others are lighter and weaker. And we don't have to go searching through our self for ways to liberate it; not at all.

Instead, the only requirement for self-liberation (or whatever we can agree to call it) is to develop a little awareness, which simply means to become more aware of what comes to our attention throughout the day. That is all we have to do to begin unraveling the Self.


Every reaction that we have is based on something we have previously identified-with enough to register or log it into our Self as good, bad, or indifferent. So, when we bump into that attachment again on the road of life and react, just look at the reaction and do some Reaction Tonglen with it. Tonglen is as simple as acknowledging the reaction, accepting it as our own projection, embracing or taking it in as ours, and then just dropping it in response. In other words, make peace with your own reactions.

Tonglen is the Mahayana Buddhist practice for the type of self-liberation practice described here, while in Vajrayana Buddhism, another form of meditation practice is used called Mahamudra.

As pointed out, we don't have to dig in or hunt through the memory-collection of the Self for sensitive hotspots to do Reaction Tonglen with. It is enough to just relax and allow the self to bring events to mind, one reaction at a time as our day unfolds. Just watch the show. With our perpetual fountain of reactions, we can undo attachment to the Self one response at a time.

Of course this may take quite a while, but we can mix this practice with our daily routine. In fact, that is the preferred way to do it, like: all day long. As each reaction comes to mind, as we are aware that we are reacting, we just neutralize it with some Reaction Tonglen to take the starch out of it, a reaction at a time.

Sure, some deep identifications will take repeated treatment, perhaps even months or years, but by attending to the reactions that bloom in the moment, gradually, like a glacier melts, we will reduce the frozen mass of the self to something manageable, and it will thin out and become transparent.

Our goal is not to deny or get rid of our self. The Buddhists say that can't be done anyway, because we would just have to go out and invent another personal assistant to help us get through the day. The Self is a necessary middleman but does not have to get in the way.

What we want to do is tone down the attachment to the Self, thin it out until it is no longer an obstacle, and does not stand in our way. In time the Self will become transparent, and we can gradually see through it and begin to identify with the awareness beyond and behind it. Our innate awareness surrounds the Self, and not vice-versa.

As an added bonus, concurrent with this process of deconstructing the Self, we end up transferring our consciousness from the Self and learn to identify with the pure awareness that is our mind, rather than with the composite-self that we have created and drawn around us. In fact, the deconstructing of the Self is simultaneous with our taking up the vantage point of a more pure awareness. That is the process of enlightenment.



Another reason is because of who Eleanor Bach was as a pioneer in our field to so many students of astrology and that she was my teacher and friend, and eventually a colleague who wrote many articles on all the four main asteroids back in the 1990s in WTPE before her untimely passing. I am also including her timed birth chart with this feature. While as we publish our first GPS Astrology magazine in the summer of 2022 Pallas is in Gemini, on the last day of August Pallas in Gemini will make an exact harmonious trine to a retrograding Vesta in Aquarius. On October 5, Vesta will make a direct station at 23 degrees of Aquarius and then Vesta will re-enter Pisces on November 20 and remain in the twelfth sign of the zodiac until February 7. 2023. One more personal note. My mother was born in NYC on January 11, 1919 and Eleanor Bach was born on the same day three years later in 1922.

Planets represent very specific principles of energy. For instance (and very briefly): Mars represents action and initiative, the onset or start of things. Venus represents reception and passivity, the conclusion or consummation of things. All of the other planets and asteroids represent various other kinds of activity. But, as we all know, the planets are mediated by, colored by the function of the signs through which they are passing, and therefore show the most amazingly

different faces in each of the signs. It is as though there are 12 different Mars, 12 different Venuses, etc

Therefore the stations of the planets afford us an opportunity to study and observe a specific principle of energy (a planet or asteroid) and how it may manifest in a specific sign. That is because the planet having the station spends far more time in the sign wherein the station occurs than it would if it were merrily moving along at normal speed. This manifestation is clearest and most intense in the two or three weeks before and after the station. And, I might add, the very degree where the station occurs is sensitized in the nature of the planet that had the station, and that sensitivity will persist for many months. Aspects made by the other planets to that sensitive degree will stimulate the action and show a further development with regard to the issues that were in consciousness in the world at the times of the stations.

Since the Pallas Station June 26 in 11 Pisces 16 is so closely conjunct the degree of the Vesta Station July 12 in 12 Pisces 12, there will be a meshing of the Vesta and Pallas Principles. For one thing, the Pallas idea of better control and/or greater efficiency will be deeply involved with regard to all Vesta matters. But the ramifications are even greater than that.

Vesta in Pisces

Vesta, in the sign ruled by Neptune, will often manifest with an emphasis on security matters or matters of trust, having to do with: the church, nuns, the priesthood and with the priestly class of various other spiritual associations. There may be concern with regard to the wealth, assets and property of the church or sect.

Betrayal of the vow of celibacy among the religious could be an issue; what with the mushrooming realization that there is so much homosexuality and pederasty among the supposedly celibate, and with so many priests forsaking their calling in order to marry, it is becoming more and more difficult to get candidates

for the priesthood in the Catholic Church. This abandonment of celibacy may be seen as a betrayal of spiritual trust; the disgusting abuse of young children by irresponsible priests certainly is.


We may see an intensification of conservative or fundamentalist religious sentiment among a variety of spiritual sects, clans, or groups. The moslems for instance. The Branch-Davidians? Spiritual security a concern. After all, religion is—after death insurance. With Vesta in Pisces, there may be a deep interest in spiritual truth.

I would expect there to be concern about safety with regard to chemicals, drugs. One would expect a greater emphasis on drug testing to assure the safety of certain therapeutic drugs. There should be increased investment in Chemicals, also Chemo-therapy may be significantly highlighted with this position of Vesta.

With the Pallas involvement, we may find incredible development in connection with the certification of vaccines or chemical aids to the immune system, and ingenuity and greater efficiency with regard to health and hospital insurance.

Have you noticed that the last station of Vesta was in 11 Virgo 15? Virgo is a sixth house sign; work and health. This station of Vesta is in Pisces, the twelfth house sign; hospitals and institutions. And this station in 12 Pisces 12 is barely a degree away from exact opposition to that last station of Vesta in 11 Virgo 15. Clearly we are getting signals that the issues of efficiency (Pallas) with regard to health (Virgo), hospitals (Pisces) and insurance (Vesta) are the big subjects on people's minds this year.



The Drug Tsar, and/or drug Mafia in the spotlight. (I believe a "Drug Tsar" has been appointed?) Pallas adds: Better use of Hi-Tech systems to control the drug problem; perhaps with regard to border patrol (Vesta is borders).

One of Vesta's negative manifestations is with regard to gangs. So many young men, children, boys and girls are banding together in gangs. These throw-away kids are more or less without families (Vesta, family, be-longing), and so they form a sort of family by becoming members of a gang.

They give themselves fancy names and wear uniforms.

They are immature, armed and lethal. They kill members of rival gangs, rivals over drug-turf. They are hoods, hoodlums. I have wondered where does the word "hood" come from? neighborhood? brotherhood? sisterhood? Actually "hood" seems to indicate whole categories or should we say "families" of things; childhood. priesthood, motherhood, etc. The gangsters of the thirties were called "Hoods." The hood, as an object, is a covering for the head, and so it may indicate the monk's cowl, as well as the peaked hood of the robes of the KKK. Count among these gangs, the "skin-heads;" racist groups which are also springing up in Europe as well as here. This gang-forming phenomenon is beginning to show up in



unexpected places and to threaten peaceful law-abiding communities. An ominous and dangerous development, fascistic in nature. They are a law unto themselves. How sad it is that the really deep need these kids have for belonging, and to feel safe, sheltered and protected, is the motivating factor in the creation of these destructive gangs.

Safety at sea and in the air may be issues with Vesta in Pisces. [Marc Jones claimed that Neptune and Pisces have as much to do with air travel as with ships; in both cases control is turned over to the ship or airplane captain, and the travel is conducted along rivers or lanes of either water or air currents. Neptune and Pisces seem to have more to do with rivers on land and river-like currents in the oceans, while Cancer and the Moon have to do with vast oceans and tides.

A colleague of ours, Suzanne Gagne, pointed this out to me. One of the mythological stories associated with Neptune is that he contended with Pallas to be tutelary deity of Attica. Whoever produced the greater gift to the region would be chosen. Neptune struck the earth with his trident and produced a river. Pallas produced the olive and she won the contest, for the olive was judged to be the superior gift.

Airplane or ship building or shipping contracts may be important. I would also expect the testing and licensing of river and sea and air pilots and captains to be of interest to many people. With Pallas involved, air-traffic controllers may be being licensed. Also there may the improvements in the methods and techniques of air traffic control—and river control.

There may be much confusion about the integrity of certain borders and boundaries (Bosnia-Herzegovina?). The terrible flooding of the Mississippi has wiped out not only the borders of the shores of the rivers, but the borders of private property and of cities, even some State borders.] Pallas, by the way, is the engineer (in Pisces she is also the ship's pilot on rivers) and certainly, with all this flooding, river (Pisces) engineering (Pallas) has loomed as a major safety (Vesta) concern; Levees, dams, dikes, bridges.

Flooding and hurricane insurance important. Pallas may supply better and more efficient ways for citizens to be

informed of and prepared for hurricanes, flooding; perhaps there will be hi-tech developments to facilitate such information.

Home (Vesta) on water (Pisces), near water. Lake or shore-side (Pisces) real estate (Vesta). House-boat (Vesta-Pisces) (yachts?). Off-shore water rights may be an issue. [Vesta is turf and, in Pisces, the turf is water.] Public or welfare (Pisces) housing (Vesta) —housing projects or help for the needy to purchase homes?

Water pollution and therefore water purification, water safety (Pisces-Vesta) an issue. Safety in water—lifeguard, life-vest or life-jacket. Investment in fish, seafood and the safety of fish or seafood for human consumption. Inspection of seafood to assure its suitability for sale.

Natural gas for fuel or heating could increase in significance. Pallas wants greater efficiency in the use of those materials.

Espionage and clandestine investigations involving the secret service agencies (Vesta) could be important. Since Pallas has so much to do with industry, industrial espionage may be an issue. Welfare for the needy. Efficiency with regard to welfare says Pallas. Investment in music, photography, film, dance. Great interest in the ethnic aspect of these Neptunian-Piscean arts, i.e., with Vesta in Pisces there was a show on Public Television about dance as it has taken form in many different cultures—ethnic dance; American Indian, Australian aborigine, Balinese, Japanese, certain African cultures, etc. The spiritual aspect of dance in various cultures was explored. There may be wonderful choreography as well as brilliant musical composition with Pallas involved.

Look for investment in cosmetics— Entrepreneurial investment in cosmetics, shipping, music, dance, etc.—says Pallas in Pisces.

So far this year Religious Sects have been issues: the Branch-Davidians, whose leader, David Koresh, finally on April 19 immolated himself and his followers pent up in that compound in Waco, Texas; Vesta was in Aquarius at the time, very appropriate for they were a group, and a weird one too, as Aquarius often is.


There is so often an element of sadness and sacrifice when planets have stations in Pisces. When the planet is Vesta, look for betrayal of trust, sacrifice of security, loss of homes, bereaved families.

Eleanor Bach, the pioneer in introducing the four main asteroids (Ceres, Pallas. Juno and Vesta) to astrological analysis, was a professional astrologer and writer. The author of A Graphic Ephemeris of Sensitive Degrees: Planet Stations and Eclipses from 1900 to 2000, the publisher of Planet Watch monthly for many years, and the creator-author of the hard-cover Ephemerides of the Asteroids: Ceres, Pallas, Juno Vesta 1900 - 2000 in 1973 which opened the gates for thousands of astrologers worldwide to start exploring the 4 main asteroids in astrological research and consultations. Eleanor received the second annual Marc Edmund Jones Award at an AFAN conference. Eleanor dedicated her profound masterwork Ephemerides to Marc Edmund Jones, writing "I dedicate this work to my dearest and best teacher." Eleanor Bach died on April 30, 1995 in NYC.
















THESE ARE TIMES THAT TRY OUR SOULS








ASTRO-LOCALITY MAPS AND CHARTS

You will see on this page the chart, calculated for Washington, D.C., for the Sun entering Cancer on June 21, 2022 (the day of the Solstice) as well as a corresponding World Map of Astro-Locality lines signifying the Rising, Setting, Above, and Below energies for the Sun, Moon and Planets.

(Hint for newcomers to the field of Astro-Locality mapping – celestial lines that are Rising and Setting appear as arcs in Yellow while celestial lines that are Above and Below appear vertically in Red. If you see the celestial symbols in Red at the Top of the Map, these are Above placements whereas if you see the celestial symbols in Red at the Bottom on the Map, these are Below placements. With the Yellow Rising and Setting arcs, if you see the symbol for the conjunction aspect that means the line is Rising whereas if you see the symbol for the opposition aspect that means the line is Setting.

These are the some of the basics, but will give you an initial help in deciphering these all-important Astrology-Locality maps.)




When warring, it is a great advantage to have accurate intelligence on when and where to engage in battle or set up defenses.


The absolute advantage of having fresh intelligence on the geographic and timing qualities is covered by two military geniuses, writing in their own times. The two classics on conducting war were Sun Tzu's, The Art of War (sometime between 770-221 BCE); and Clausewitz's, On War (1832).

In both works, the topic of place comes up. The first of The Sun Tzu's five keys to victory was, "...knowing when to fight and when not to." In the chapter on Deployment, he admonishes, "In the Art of War, first comes scoping, then measurement, then calculation, then balancing and finally victory. The Earth is the basis for scoping, scoping the basis for measurement..." One more tidbit, "Thus if you know in advance the time and place of engagement, you can march a thousand li and still join battle."

Clausewitz wrote in chapter three of book one, "the relationship between warfare and terrain determines the peculiar character of military action.... To master it a special gift is need, which is given the too restricted name of a sense of locality." As to timing, he says, "War is the realm of chance."

These quotes set the stage for what I want to present. My entire life has been lived in the bosom and shadow

of the American Military Industrial Complex. I study war and its relationships. Let me repeat, I study war's relationships and I have realized an amazing pattern in the U.S., July 4, 1776, 'birth' moment. There is a 'map of reality' that discloses extraordinary U.S. military relationships.

In a recent conversation with Mark Lerner, we discussed my anxious mindset recovering from covid, and how I focused upon my breath, we pondered our lived realization that every moment of time is precious and we, the living, have relationship to all of it.

Simultaneously, in the backdrop of our lives a new space telescope, the Webb, has brought into focus a vast field of new relationships, a new cosmos, which humans, up until now, have been completely ignorant of. We now, in a time when the tide of existential challenges is daunting, face the task of integrating this newly revealed knowledge of relationships into our strategies for navigating life. This might be a *Don't Look Up* moment for humanity.

Recently it was announced that planet Earth officially has 8 billion human inhabitants, tied together by the pattern I discovered (and named) for America's military. Not all of them have firsthand experiences of the war's manifestations. Indeed, numerically, only a fraction of a percent suffers from the physical impacts today's armies with their artillery, drones, bomb blasts, bullets, and tanks. But war is like the covid virus, with its effects compelling a relationship with everyone (eventually) and seeping everywhere. War is seen not just in the spectacle of armed soldiers, battlefields, but in the migrations of family, the food insecurity, the economic impacts, and the living casualties of war, suffering from PTSD, choking our streets.


Again, our Earth relationships are universal, but much is

is unrealized, like the new, unfamiliar celestial sky just revealed by the Webb telescope. Many in the world are connected today, but unaware of the cost of playing with the wiring.

Wait for it...!

The Eisenhower Administration created, as part of the newly formed Pentagon (DoD), the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA). But DARPA was not part of the regular DoD military research division. On June 3, 2021, UK's Economist Magazine published that ARPA/DARPA, "is the agency that shaped the modern world…"

DARPA, funded by Congress, is said to be the driver of the U.S. Military Industrial Complex that POTUS Eisenhower warned about on January 17, 1961, as he left office. There's something about that January 17th date for U.S. military adventures - think Desert Storm launched January 17, 1991.



While enjoying the benefits of living in a Military Industrial Complex, there are many relationships that are held Top Secret that you might object to. Some of you readers can recall from the movie classic, The Wizard of Oz, Dorothy's dog Toto discovering the Oz operating behind a curtain. It was a great shock. Some secrets are diabolical, and are hidden in plain sight. They are wrapped in benefits that serve billions, which makes them respectable. One DARPA innovation - GPS system, fits this description and would have caught Sun Tzu's and Clausewitz's attention.

Consider this short list of other DARPA innovations that have shaped the world we co-inhabit. DARPA was responsible for such familiar items as: Agent Orange, airliners, digital cameras, hearts and minds campaigns, Duct tape, low light photography, the microwave ovens, and the big one, the ARPANET, which evolved into the internet – the world-wide-web (WWW).

Back to GPS. February 22, 3:44 p.m., PST, 1978 was a world changing moment. At that moment a rocket was launched from Vandenberg AFB, CA. carrying Navstar1, the first of 24 Navstar navigation satellites. This was the launch of the DoD satellite-based Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) system. The system's intellectual foundations are Einstein's special and general relativity theories, dealing with time. Specifically the system determined location, plotted navigation in three-dimensions, allowing accurate tracking around the Earth, mapping the geography of the Earth, and the establishment of exact 'universal' time. All of which is of great strategic value during war.



Astrologers have the perfect tool-belt to make all this actionable. This world-changing moment, from 1978, fits nicely into the timing of today, August 11th, 2022, the inauguration of Mark Lerner's *GPS Astrology Magazine*. Literally, GPS is helping his journalism shine forth into the world.

GPS has transformed war! Navigation, timing and tracking innovations have led to tremendous improvements in U.S. military AWAC systems, moving from human navigators to more advanced computer directed flying command platforms, like the E-3 Sentry. These high flying platforms operate over battlefields conspicuous with their piggy-backed saucers: operations, synchronizing providing navigation information, pinpointing targets, locating personnel. directing tactical moves.

The GPS relationship is the brain of the drone aircraft, like the Global Hawk and infamous Predator, and it informed the Abrams tank computers, navigating them to overwhelming victory over Iraqi tankers, during Operation Desert Storm. Eventually, GPS would inform the artillery, helicopters, smartphones, etc. used on the Afghanistan and Iraq battlefields - America's longest wars.

Unpacking the facts of the GPS moment would be particularly precious for astrologers and those they serve. The understanding of symbol, place and the flow of time can be made actionable, adding to one's skill set. Think agency! The GPS is a man-made reality physically functioning in Earth's atmosphere, while reflecting symbolic realities. In that physical realm of the sky the U.S. has taken a large lead, amongst the militaries of the world. With this advantage the U.S. has militarized the heavens with the introduction of GPS guided Predator Drones, armed with smart Hellfire missiles.

Meanwhile, on the Earth, in many American communities across the mainland, military assault weapons, like the AR (Armalite) -15, a version of the

DoD's AR-16 used during the Vietnam War, are being used to massacre civilians. A perverse lesson in the truth of "As Above, so below!"

For millennia, Mars was the astrology planet corresponding with war - the Red planet. The planet Mars in the GPS horoscope is in the 12th house at 22 Cancer 37' retrograde. As Mark and I pondered, every moment has a relationship with every other moment, making the 1978 GPS moment Mars alignment to the Mercury (24 Cancer 12' retrograde) of the U.S. horoscope moment from July 4, 4:47 p.m., 1776, in Philadelphia not just related but extremely relevant, because of its proximity. Mercury is about realities in the air and communications, realms where the U.S. assumed leadership in the world. Again, notably, the U.S. pioneered placing military (Mars) machines in the Earth's atmosphere and invented the internet.

In the late 20th and early 21st Century the U.S. and GPS were joined-at-the-hip. Now it's getting crowded in the sky and DARPA has been busy developing a whole new system that doesn't require satellites.

The GPS horoscope lists a table of the Declinations of planets. In this table Mars is at +25 25', way Out-of-Bounds. For a horoscope planet to be beyond 23.5 degrees, north or south of the equator is to be way out-of-bounds and the point of emphasis.

This Mars emphasis seems to have been the open secret of the February 22nd, 1978, moment. Old school astrologers learned that the 12th house was the house of self-undoing, of secret enemies, an example of a cautionary tale, of self-undoing through a diabolical, Frankenstein monster invention. We shouldn't be surprised by this, after all the GPS system was developed by DARPA.

For another, more grounded perspective of the U.S. horoscope and GPS maps of reality, they can be

converted into familiar 2-dimensional maps annotated with astrological legends and symbols.

I use such a map to show a pattern I researched (2013-2014) and dubbed the War Impulse Pattern (WIP). Note that lines labeled Mars and Neptune are running through NATO countries. They trace through geography where the U.S. has history. U.S. treasure is being spent all around the lines in July 2022, as U.S. boots are deployed on the ground and U.S. advanced weapons of war, Abrams tanks, computers, drones, HIMARS missile systems, night vision, and the universally used iPhones are being pre-positioned or sold to NATO members. Most iPhones are manufactured in Zhengzhou, China under a branch of the WIP.

Now, please look at the attached map and take note of all four of the GPS Ground Stations tight within U.S. WIP Template lines. This is no mean coincidence. This knowledge is a strategic advantage in time of war.



In this extraordinary map, the WIP template has branches (35 North latitude) running through Tehran, Iran. In my 2019 book, *War Impulse Pattern - Primer to Not on the Map*, captioning my last map (page #95) showing Tehran, Iran, I wrote, "great danger exists."

An Interview with Isha Lerner By Erin M. Kelly

At a time when people run the risk of losing their imaginations to excessive television and mass-media advertising, the *Inner Child Cards*, created by two professional astrologers with extensive backgrounds in tarot symbols, acted on a wonderful vision of fairy tales and the tarot. They explored the idea one summer morning in 1988, at the time of a full moon. They found the mystical force of the tarot to be a graceful companion to the mystery teachings of fairy tales and myth in a deck of cards for children and the young at heart.

"Revelations showered down on us like brilliant falling stars," said authors Isha and Mark Lerner. "We were impregnated by a vision and wisdom beyond ourselves. To say this project has been inspiring for us would be an understatement."

It had been an ongoing manifestation since an initial meeting at the Findhorn Foundation in Forres, Scotland, in 1977, where Isha and Mark met up with several hundred people working with personal transformation and planetary service. Together they set free the ideas and inspirations that were gestating for several years. The deck is like a butterfly, liberated from the cocoon, open to the light and dancing with the fire.

"My deepest inspiration was my own pain and childhood longings, and learning through teachings of my mother who was strong and respectable," Isha said. "She taught us that our tears are the elixir and that our pain is an unpolished jewel of potential radiance. My deepest hope is to bring forward that message."

The deck has been translated in six languages, hitting a worldwide audience. "It has been very rewarding," Isha said. Many specialists are using the cards for past life




recall, in children's shelters and for child therapy. They are also used in remembering the lost innocence of childhood memories and have been inspirational in opening the channel of the heart. "It's really incredible what children see in these cards," Lerner said.

Inner Child Cards are an evolutionary expression of the wisdom and magic of the tarot. The tarot is an ageless body of knowledge whose origin is not determined. However, the first actual tarot deck was recorded to be found in the twelfth century in Europe. In the Inner Child Cards, suggestion of early imprints of rhyme, riddle and verse become the stepping stone toward maturation and imagination for those who study them. Hundreds of decks continued to be created - from many cultures and in all corners of the world. In designing the Inner Child Cards, Mark and Isha Lerner have revealed the beauty, wisdom, joy and innocence embedded in the twentytwo Major Trumps. "We were striving to create a deck that parents, teachers and families could utilize without getting lost in a myriad of arcane meanings that are difficult to fathom," Isha said.



Isha and Mark Lerner were inspired to create these cards through curiosity and innocence. "We wanted a deck to be safe in the hands of people of all ages including children. I have three daughters ages 20, 18 and 6, and it was important to do this for them. My husband at the time and I put our heart and soul into this project and worked on it for seven years. It was part of our own journey to find wholeness again..." Isha explained.




The ornate cards were visualized by Isha after meditating on each image. "I brought the image down and then had them illustrated by Christopher Guilfoil." Impressionistic and colorfully vibrant, the Inner Child Cards stir the imagination and express the movement of the cards' meaning. The tarot images help to bridge the faceted pieces of our broken self. These images probe the soul, unveil the power of light and dark and unleash the impulse to understand desire, love and conflict. From the deep perception of "story hood" archetypes comes the awakening of subconscious forces that, in time, heal the spirit. For instance, the story of "Sleeping Beauty" and the Death card are parallel in meaning if you understand the deeper messages of personal metamorphosis at the core of the fairy tale and the thirteenth Trump. In an interesting way, children are being taught about the magic of the tarot and the twenty-two-fold path of destiny through fairy tales. They have been given a "key" to the treasure chest of the hidden meaning in fairy tales and ancient folklore. Inner Child Cards has ordered the fairy tales into a magical sequence on the royal road of the tarot.

"These stories of yesteryear imply solutions. They are never meant to give answers, to judge, to punish or to dismiss the reality that, while we are mortal beings, we are not unlike the magnificent fairies, angels and wizards encountered in childhood literature," Lerner says.



The measure of how high or low a note is relative to other notes. Pitch is determined by the frequency of vibrations per second of the sound-producing agent.


Duration

The last time Pluto was at 27 degrees Capricorn, the American colonies were in the middle of fighting a bitter war against the British. In the middle of this war – on July 4th 1776 – independence was declared. Major battles were still being fought – in Boston, Long Island, White Plains, Trenton, Princeton, Brandywine and many more. Many of these battles were lost, but in 1781 at Yorktown, George Washington finally prevailed. 
